### Mission

“Cancer in 2026: From Diagnosis to Reconstruction” is a multidisciplinary scientific conference dedicated to the full clinical journey of the cancer patient — from molecular diagnostics and personalised medicine to immunotherapy, surgical oncology, survivorship, and reconstructive care. The conference aims to promote interdisciplinary collaboration, patient-centred oncology, and contemporary cancer education among future healthcare professionals.

### Audience

The conference is addressed to medical students, CMKP trainees, junior physicians, researchers, and internationally oriented participants interested in modern multidisciplinary oncology and integrated cancer care.

### Organisers

The conference is organised at the Medical University of Warsaw in collaboration with the Oncology Clinic of WUM and the Student Scientific Society affiliated with the Clinic.

### Institutional Patronages
